

Rules and Regulations

Preregistration Required: email registration to n2eqynz@aol.com, or fax to 703-759-9845

Entries will be accepted from March 1 until April 25, 2012.

USEA - The show will be run according to USEA Rules for Eventing.

Combined Training Divisions: Each division will have a maximum of ten entries; if additional entries warrant, divisions will be added.

Rising Stars - USDF Introductory Test A, Jumps 18" max.

Baby Novice - USEA Beginner Novice Test A, Jumps 2' max.

Beginner Novice - USEA Beginner Novice Test B, Jumps 2'7" max.

Novice - USEA Novice Test A, Jumps 2'11" max.

Entry Fees: \$50 per entry in Combined Training
\$30 per Dressage Test, Test of Choice.

Schooling: Schooling will be permitted only in designated schooling areas. There will be no schooling in the rings once they have been set up.

Coggins Test: All exhibitors must present a Negative Coggins Test report taken within one year on each animal exhibited.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for each division through sixth place.

Responsibilities: Sue Kvasnicka, Turner Farm Events, Turner Farm Park and Fairfax County Park Service, their officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident, or loss, which may occur to any exhibitor, spectator, rider, guest, groom attendant, or other employee, animal or equipment at the show. The show reserves the right to decline or accept any entry and return any entry fees before or during the show without being liable for compensation; to change the location, combine, cancel, split or limit any classes; or change any officials.

Dogs: All Dogs must be on leashes while on the showgrounds.

This show is a fundraiser for Turner Farm Park, and the proceeds will go to the Fairfax County Park Authority to maintain and enhance Turner Farm Park.
